REQUIREMENTS

- SIGNED Application
- 2 Passport Photos
- Driver's License
- Completed theory test

APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS:

- Eighteen Years or older
- Hold a Valid Driver's License
- Hold a valid Passport from country of residency

PERMIT RESTRICTIONS:

- **VALID FOR 15 YEARS**
- Valid only in conjunction with a current driver's license
- **IMPORTANT NOTE: VALID DRIVING LICENSE MUST BE CARRIED WITH THE PERMIT AT ALL TIMES**
- Not valid for driving in the United States
- Must be effective within 6 months of application date
- Does not give driving privileges

REQUIREMENTS: send application via email,

1. Attach 2 identical recent Passport Type Photos (2" X 2") signed on back
2. A photocopy of BOTH SIDES Driver's License must accompany completed signed application.
3. Completed theory exam. attached on this form

If you are traveling to a GCC (Gulf Cooperation Council) country—such as the UAE, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Qatar, Oman, or Bahrain—for a driving job, an International Driving Certificate confirms that you have passed both the theory and practical driving tests. As a result, you will be eligible to obtain a GCC work driving license without the need for additional testing

Completion of this test is mandatory for all applicants who intend to work as professional drivers in the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries — including the **United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Kuwait, Oman, and Bahrain**.

Test Format & Pass Mark

- The test consists of multiple-choice questions (MCQs).
- Each question has four options: A, B, C, and D — with only one correct answer.
- You must answer at least 50% of the questions correctly to pass.
- There is no time limit, but we recommend completing the test in one sitting.

Submission Guidelines

- If printed, mark your answers clearly with a pen.
- If completed digitally, follow instructions provided and save your answers in a readable format (e.g., PDF or Word).
- Submit the completed test together with your full application package via the provided email or in-person drop-off.

Online Etiquette & Integrity

- Do not copy answers from the internet or other applicants. Your understanding is important for your safety and professionalism.
- Use a quiet, distraction-free environment while completing the test.
- This test helps assess your readiness to drive in a foreign country where rules may differ from your home country.
